## 5<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Lent

In today's gospel (Jn 12:20-33) the time for Jesus to draw all people to himself nears. Jesus' crucifixion will glorify God by making salvation available to anyone who believes and add innumerable souls to the kingdom. Some Greeks come to worship at the Passover Feast. They ask to see Jesus. He responds, "The hour has come for the Son of Man to be glorified ... unless a grain of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it remains just a grain of wheat; but if it dies, it produces much fruit." Jesus admonishes us to follow his example to eternal life. Whoever chooses the things of this world over the teachings of Christ will lose eternal life and whoever dies to the ways of the world will gain it. Whoever loves me will act as I do and "the Father will honor whoever serves me." "Where I am, there also will my servant be." Jesus is "troubled" over having to face crucifixion but acknowledges it as the purpose he came for. At the crucifixion the Father will be glorified for the gift of salvation given to mankind. God's voice thunders: "I have glorified it [through signs] and will glorify it again" through the cross. His voice was heard for their sakes, so they may believe. Through the mystery of the cross Christ will draw everyone to himself.

Jesus has drawn us close by making us part of His family. We don't have to ask permission to see Jesus because we have constant access. The cross made our bodies worthy dwellings for the Holy Spirit. We are changed by Him through the Sacraments of the Eucharist and Reconciliation, Adoration, and prayer. We are connected to Him through these graces of salvation and the sanctification process (our crosses). We are fruitful when we die to self-centeredness through practicing the Faith. Otherwise, we remain only a grain of wheat. Through detachment we discover a union with Jesus available to those who follow Him. The fruits of the Spirit manifest (love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control) and increase until they are second nature. When trouble comes, use the prayer Jesus said in the Garden: "Father, if thou art willing, remove this cup from me; nevertheless, not my will, but thine, be done" (Lk 22:42). Then "where I am, there also will my servant be" gradually becomes a reality. We find ourselves more often in places where only the love of Jesus goes. Reaching out to those in need, caring about everyone (friend or foe), and pointing others to Jesus. "Rejoice always, pray constantly, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you" (1Thes. 5:16-18). Are you bearing fruit?
